Dear Prospective Judge Basketball Player and Parents:

Most of you are now completing a basketball season. We hope you enjoyed the year and look forward to playing basketball in the future. We are going to have our annual spring basketball camp for players in parochial and public junior high schools.

The Judge camp will be held for boys currently in 6th, 7th or 8th grade. The two-fold purpose of the camp will be instructional and motivational. We hope to give the players some basic fundamentals to work on and to motivate the participants to play basketball year round to improve skills and most importantly, to realize the great life values that can become a part of you through a profitable athletic experience.

Our camp will be held from March 31 through April 5. Players are expected to be on the Judge floor at 6:15 PM each day, Monday, thru Thursday (no camp on Friday). The camp activities will end at 8:25 each evening. Saturday will be a day of competition and games will depend on the number of participants. The schedule will begin at 9:00 AM.

The camp will be conducted by Judge coaches in conjunction with several of the players from this year's 3A State *Championship Team*. The Judge team has played in 36 state tournaments in the last 41 years, including a record string of sixteen consecutive appearances, making the "Final Four" 15 times. The Judge Memorial Basketball team has also been honored to be again invited to the prestigious Alhambra National Catholic Invitational Tournament now 12 times, finishing in the top five in eight of these tournaments. The camp is hopefully an extension of this tradition as well as the tradition of totally outstanding young men who have been part of Judge basketball and pride of our togetherness and "WE" feeling of the Judge family.

A fee of \$35.00 will be charged each participant. Players will receive a Judge basketball practice shirt. Those interested need to send a check or money order along with their name, school and grade in which currently enrolled. **Mail fee and information in care of Coach Jim Yerkovich.** Checks need to be made out to BULLDOG BASKETBALL.

There is a possibility, if enrollment for spring camp is too large, an additional session will be arranged. We will also have our annual summer camp to be held the first five weeks of the summer and conducted in five age levels. Information will be available at our spring camp.
