Stewart Allen Leads Judge Memorial Past Bountiful

Senior attackman Stewart Allen scored seven goals to lead Judge Memorial to a 13-8 victory over previously-unbeaten Bountiful in a Utah High School Lacrosse League Division A game Friday afternoon.

Senior middle Joe MacPherson added five points on two goals and three assists, senior middle Kyle Brennan scored twice and senior middle Anthony Duke-Rosati had a goal and an assist to help lead Judge Memorial (5-1).

Judge Memorial led 6-5 at halftime but broke the game open in the third quarter with a four-goal run. Judge Memorial led 10-5 going into the final 12 minutes, and Bountiful closed the gap to three goals at 11-8 in the final period, but that was as close as it could get.

"It was a total team effort," Judge Memorial Coach David Allen said. "Between the restraining lines, our middies did well. The attack was patient and took a lot of good shots, and our defense shut down their leading scorer."

In a losing effort, sophomore attackman Zack Jordan scored four goals, senior attackman Derek Walker added three points on two goals and an assist and senior middle Bradford Davis had a goal and an assist for Bountiful (7-1), which had its seven-game winning streak snapped.

"We didn't play very well," Bountiful Coach Marty Wescott said. "We kind of lost our composure a little bit. It was a good lesson for us, and hopefully we'll come out stronger next game."
