## **Kaschmitter's 17 Saves Helps Judge Memorial Past Bonneville**

Alex Kaschmitter is growing up fast.

Judge Memorial's sophomore first-year starting goalie made 17 saves on Wednesday night to lead his team to a 9-5 victory over visiting Bonneville in a Utah High School Lacrosse League Division A game.

"I think we could've played better," Judge Memorial Coach David Allen said. "We kind of got a little sloppy with our passing, and we made some poor decisions on offense, but my defense played very well."

Andy Scott scored three goals, Stewart Allen had two goals and an assist and Jack Lund had two goals for Judge Memorial. Joe MacPherson, who drew double-teams all night, added four assists.

Judge Memorial, now 7-1, took a 4-1 lead in the first quarter and led 7-2 at the half en route to its fourth victory in a row. Bonneville fell to 6-2.
