### Utah Track and Field

#### Utahns in Arcadia Invitational

Several local athletes competed in one of the biggest track meets in the west, the Arcadia Invitational in Arcadia, Calif., over the weekend.

In the Invitational Division, Davis High's **Ashlee Cannon** placed fourth in the 300-meter hurdles. Judge Memorial's **Samantha McMillian** was fifth in the mile, finishing in 4 minutes, 59.95 seconds, the fastest time for a Utah prep runner this year.

Also, Judge Memorial's **Colin Boevers** threw 181 feet, 9 inches in the discus to earn a fifth-place finish.

### Paralympics

#### Salt Lake skier honored

Salt Lake City resident **Steve Cook**, who won two gold medals and a bronze in cross country skiing at the Turin Paralympics last month, is the U.S. Olympic Committee's male athlete of the month for March.

The 37-year-old Cook, a four-time Paralympian who lost his lower right leg in a 1988 farming accident, collected gold medals in the men's 5-kilometer freestyle and 10K classic style races. He also won a bronze in the 20K classic race, personally accounting for 25 percent of the 12 medals won by the U.S. at the Games for athletes with physical disabilities.

Team honors went to the U.S. sled hockey team, which won a bronze medal at the Turin Paralympics, while figure skater **Kimmie Meissner** is March's female athlete of the month
