Judge offers 24 AP courses and 24 Honors courses across 8 subjects. Students enrolled in an AP class must take an associated AP Exam. In 2023, 341 students took 629 AP exams. 2 seniors earned the AP Capstone Diploma; 19 students received the AP Scholar distinction. 67% of the AP exams taken by our class of 2023 seniors received a score of 3,4, or 5. AP seminar is cross-listed as English 10 Honors and the grade students receive in that class is weighted as an AP class. They also participate in the AP Seminar exam.

The cumulative GPA is based on all grades received in ninth through twelfth grades. A distinction is made in assigning grade points for AP and Honors level courses. An AP course receives an extra point added to the GPA; an Honors course receives an extra half credit point.

Judge Memorial does not award an A+ for any classes and we do not rank.

Judge Memorial's Campus Ministry program, deeply rooted in the school's culture, values Peer Ministers.
