**Peer Ministry Description:** Peer Ministry is an academic, leadership, and service opportunity at Judge Memorial Catholic High School. Beyond planning and ministering at Liturgies and retreats, Peer Ministers have the opportunity to choose, initiate and lead specific ministry and service experiences for the students at Judge. In addition to outward ministry, leadership, and service, peer ministers participate in a theology class that explores Christian apologetics, Catholic Social Teaching and service through *Tattoos* on the Heart by Greg Boyle, personal prayer, and leadership. While the experience is rigorous, peer ministers learn immensely from class and ministering to their peers.

**Requirements:** In order to be considered, junior students must complete this application in full. If any part of the application is late, the application will not be considered. The application includes a teacher nomination, personal written responses to all questions in this packet, an interview with a current Peer

Minister teacher or coach recommendation, and an in-person interview. Please know that part of the selection process is campus ministry giving teachers an opportunity to describe their experiences of applicants in their classroom and throughout the school, focusing feedback on work ethics, character, behavior, leadership, and spirituality.
